Qualifying Junior dogs will receive awards after the completion of Junior water work.

Decoys may be used for water tests in the Master only.

Directions to Luckiamute Valley Pheasants

Luckiamute Valley Pheasants is located in Western Oregon's beautiful Willamette Valley 28 miles southwest of Salem; 22 miles northwest of Corvallis, 20 miles west of Albany, 15 miles south of Dallas and 15 miles west southwest of Monmouth.

Coming from the North via I-5:

1. Take exit 260A for OR-99E/Salem Pkwy.
2. Travel on Salem Pkwy for 5 miles.
3. Turn right onto Marion St NE to OR-22(Dallas/ Oregon Coast) and go across the Marion St Bridge. (Get in the left 2 lanes).
4. Follow OR-22 west toward Dallas to the Monmouth exit (about 9.4 miles)
5. Take exit #16 to Monmouth exit and travel south on OR-99W for approximately 13 miles to Arlie Rd.
6. Turn right onto Arlie Rd (yellow blinking light).
7. Travel 7.9 miles to Maple Grove Rd.
8. Turn left on Maple Grove Rd
9. Travel 3.5 miles to OR-223 S/SW Fairview.
10. Turn left onto OR-223 and travel 1.1 miles to Ira Hooker Rd.
11. Travel 1.5 miles .
12. Turn left onto narrow dirt road at flags or sign.
13. Travel .5 miles to the headquarters.
14. Flags will be at the entrance to the reserve.

Coming from McMinnville Take

Hwy 18 West to OR-99W.

Turn south (left) toward Monmouth and travel 31.7 miles.

Turn right on Arlie and follow the directions above beginning with step 7.

Coming from the South on I-5:

Take exit #228 (Corvallis/Lebanon) to Hwy 34 to Corvallis. Travel 9.5 miles to traffic light just prior to entering Corvallis. (Be in left lanes)

Turn left to continue on Hwy 34 (Newport Corvallis Hwy) toward Philomath/Oregon Coast and travel 6.8 miles through Philomath. At junction west of Philomath, veer right onto Hwy 20 toward Toledo/Newport.

Travel 4 miles.

Turn right onto Hwy 223 (Kings Valley Hwy).

Travel for 13.1 miles.

Turn right onto Ira Hooker Rd (gravel). Travel 1.5 miles

Turn left onto narrow dirt road at flags or sign.

Travel .5 miles to headquarters.
